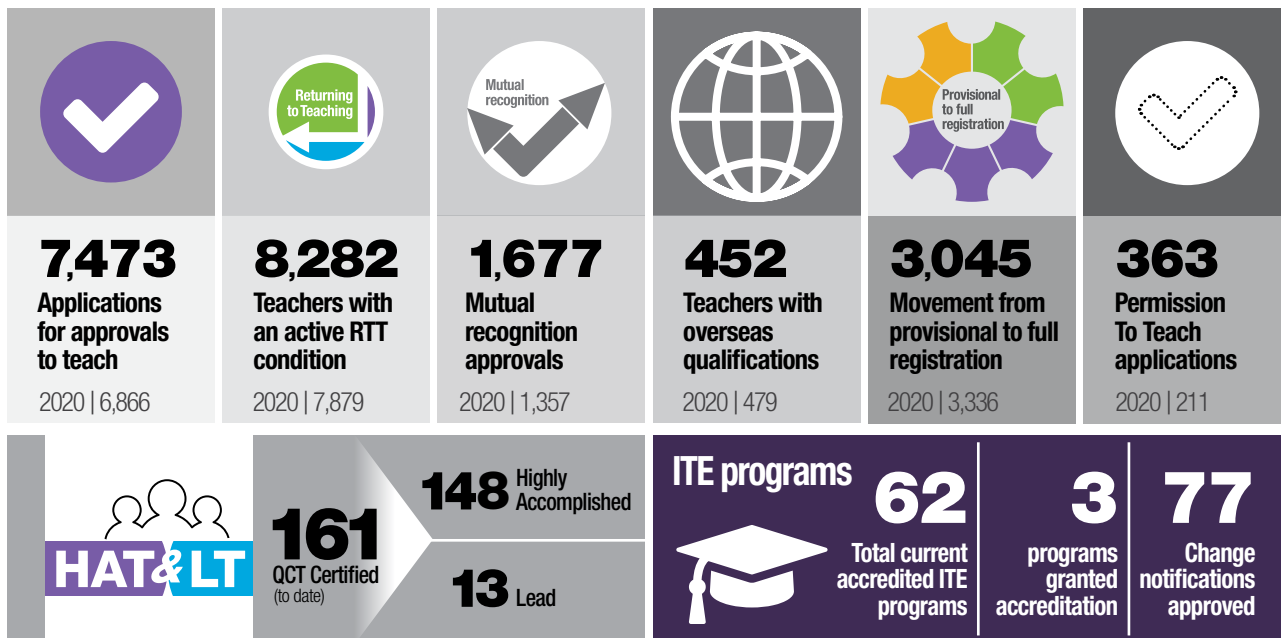

## Engagement with the profession<sup>2</sup>

Each year the QCT engages with registered and preservice teachers across Queensland to develop understanding about the use of APST across career stages and to enhance understanding of registration requirements for teachers. Engagement in 2021 was primarily through online presentations, webinars, reference groups and the provision of digital and print resources.

### 50th Anniversary celebrations

Anniversary activities included: six regional celebrations hosted by stakeholders, a Ministerial function at Parliament House, a sponsor-funded Photo Competition and a ticketed stakeholder dinner at City Hall.



QCT eNews publications sent to registered teachers promote the achievements of the profession. The email **open-rates** which averages **41%** sits well above industry rates. The top articles read focused on teacher awards and recognition of teachers' achievements.



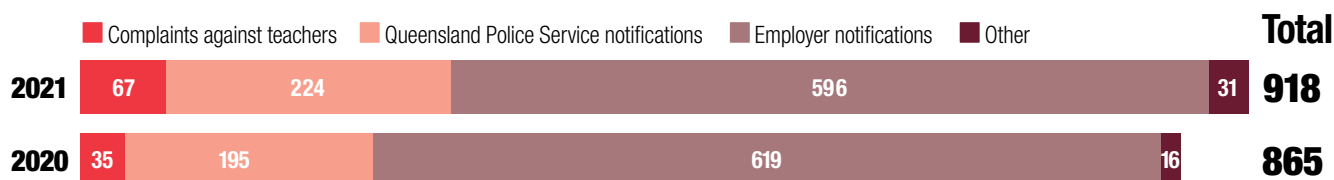
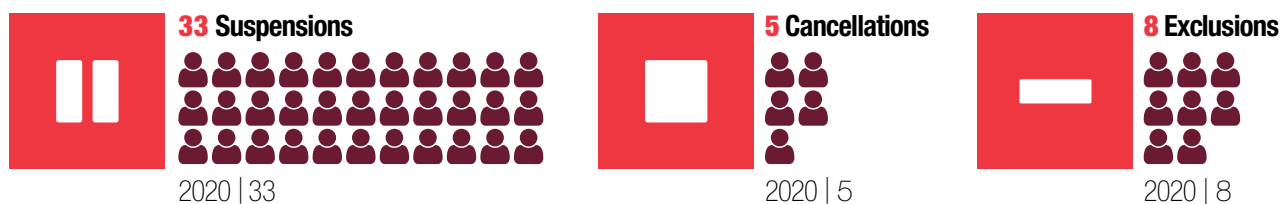

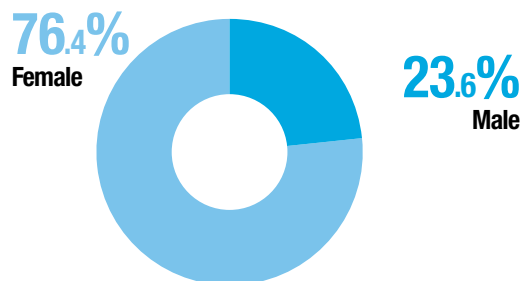

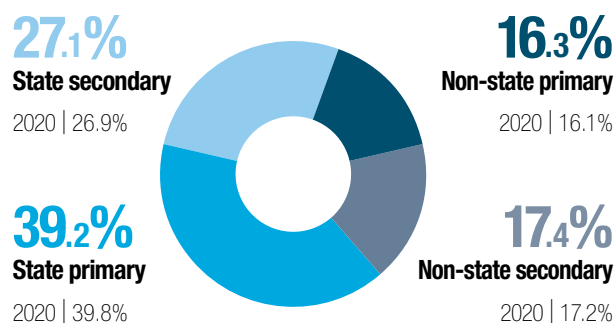
