#### QCT professional engagement sessions for 2012

During Term 2, the QCT will visit major centres in Queensland conducting workshops and information sessions about teacher registration requirements. Workshops for provisionally registered teachers focus on using professional standards in progressing to full registration, while the sessions for fully registered teachers highlight information about the CPD Framework, renewal of registration and reflective practice. This year's sessions will also include information about the national standards and other changes which will apply from 2013. A full schedule of dates and an opportunity to register for these events will be available on the QCT website in early March.



#### **QCT Teacher Research Grants – applications for 2012 now open**

The QCT provides a small number of research grants annually to practising teachers to assist them to present their research at key Australian education conferences. This initiative is part of the QCT's program of activities to promote teaching as a profession.

Queensland-registered teachers who have undertaken research related to their teaching practice or that of their colleagues are invited to apply for a grant to enable them to present their findings in a suitable national or state forum. The grant provides financial assistance to cover conference registration fees and travel and accommodation associated with conference attendance.

Applications must be on <u>the form</u> provided by the QCT and must be submitted to the QCT Office by 30 April. Please see the <u>Guidelines for</u> <u>Applicants</u>.



#### QCT Strategic Plan 2012 - 2015

#### **QCT Board reconstituted**

The Board is the governing body of the QCT. Members of the Board for the three-year term 2012 - 2014 were announced in December. The 17 Board members are nominated or elected by a range of education stakeholder groups and are appointed by the Governor in Council. The <u>reconstituted Board</u> includes a mix of new and returning members.
