Every nomination has a series of short questions. Judges use your responses to separate and rank nominations using the criteria for each award category.

In each response, establish and highlight key points that not only answer the question, but that would also set this nomination apart from other potential candidates.

Use data and examples to support your responses. Data and examples from your school or classroom context help to demonstrate impact on student learning and contributions to the school community and teaching profession.

The questions have a character or word limit. It is recommended that you edit and refine your responses to distil information presented to key points.
