Register

- The number of teachers in the register is up 1.3% compared to 2020
- 7,473 applications received up 8.8%
- 38% of applicants were Queensland graduates who had graduated in the past two years
- 4,498 teachers were removed from the register – 18.6% more than the previous year



Demographics

- The average age of applicants is 36 years
- The average age of approved teachers is 45.7 years
- 75.9% of teachers on the register are **female**
- Half of all teachers are over 45 years of age (16.8% are 60 years or older)



Employment

- At the end of 2021 69.1% of approved teachers were employed in a permanent or long-term temporary teaching position in Queensland:
- 16% in Non-State Primary schools
- 17% in Non-State Secondary schools
- 39% in State Primary schools
- 27% in State Secondary schools



Permission to Teach applicants*

- 95% enrolled in an ITE program
- 62% approved to teach in a state school
- General Primary, Design and Technologies, English, Mathematics, Health and Physical Education, the Sciences, and Humanities were prominent subject areas
